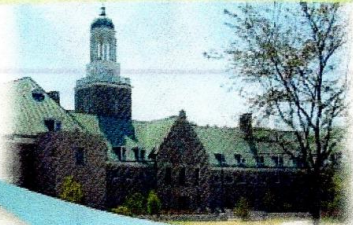

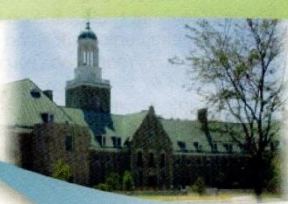

1.Directions from Hamilton via Hwy #403

Travelling East from Hamilton on Hwy. 403
Take Exit Ramp to # 6 Highway-Guelph
Proceed & stay in Right Hand Lane on #6
Take Exit ramp onto York Road
Turn Right onto York Road (*you will cross over top of Hwy # 6*)
Turn left onto Newman Road (**CAUTION!**)
At **STOP** sign turn Left onto Zellens Road
At the bend in the road turn sharp Right into the Motherhouse Laneway.

St. Joseph's Motherhouse end of Laneway.
Keep right and go *behind* the Motherhouse to the Martha Wing.

2.Directions from Hamilton via Cannon St.

Cannon Street West turns into York Blvd at Queen Street
Continue on York, passing Dundurn Castle
Turn left at the second Stop Light, onto Plains Road West (*you can only turn left*)
At the end of the road turn Left onto York Road.*(you will cross over top of Hwy # 6)*
Turn Left at Newman Road. (**CAUTION!**)
At **STOP** sign turn Left onto Zellens Road
At the bend in the road turn sharp Right into the Motherhouse Laneway.

St. Joseph's Motherhouse end of Laneway.
Keep right and go *behind* the Motherhouse to the Martha Wing.

3. Directions from Toronto via Hwy #403

Exit Hwy #403 at Ramp to #6 North-Guelph
Proceed to Right Hand Lane on Hwy # 6
Take Exit Ramp onto York Road
Turn Right onto York Road (*you will cross over top of Hwy # 6*)
Turn left onto Newman Road (**CAUTION!**)
At **STOP** sign turn Left onto Zellens Road
At the bend in the road turn sharp Right into the Motherhouse Laneway.

St. Joseph's Motherhouse end of Laneway.
Keep right and go *behind* the Motherhouse to the Martha Wing.

4.Directions from Toronto via Hwy # 401

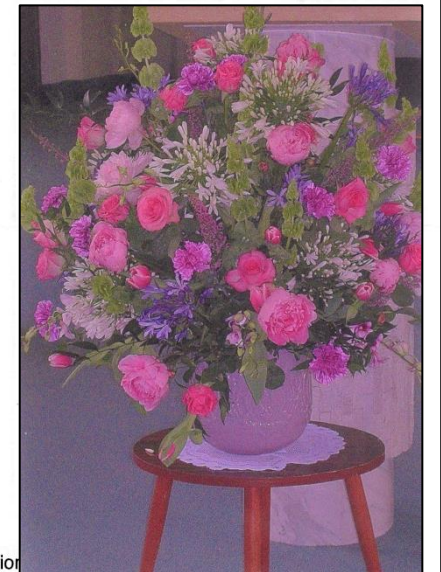
Exit Hwy.401 at the ramp to Guelph

Keep right and go *behind* the Motherhouse to the Martha Wing.

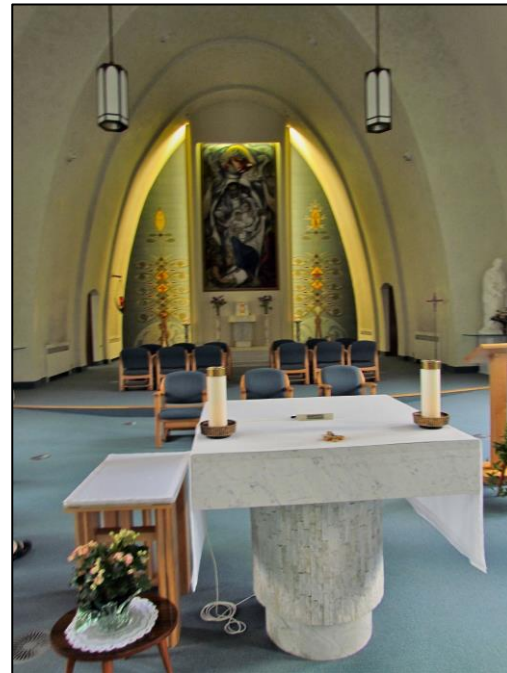
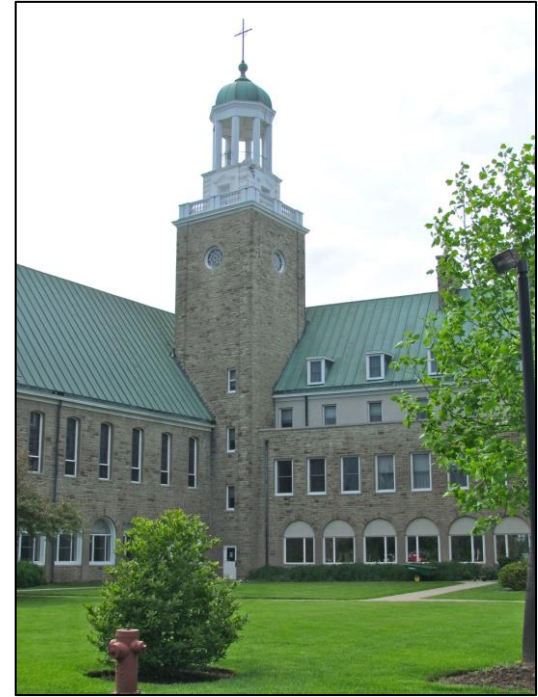
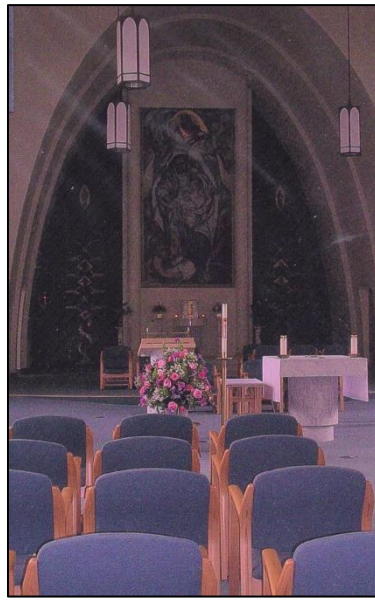

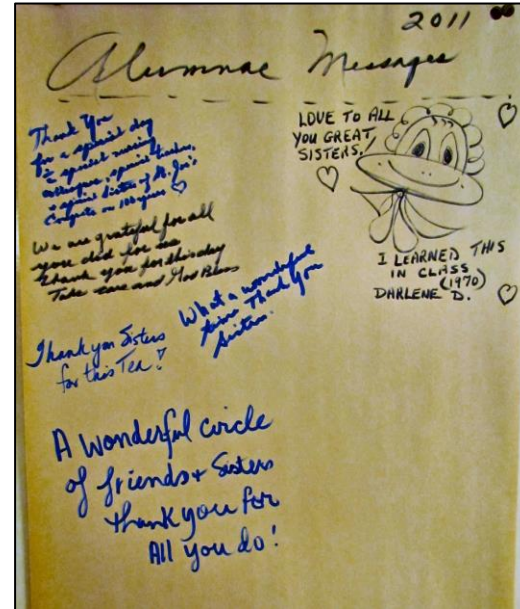
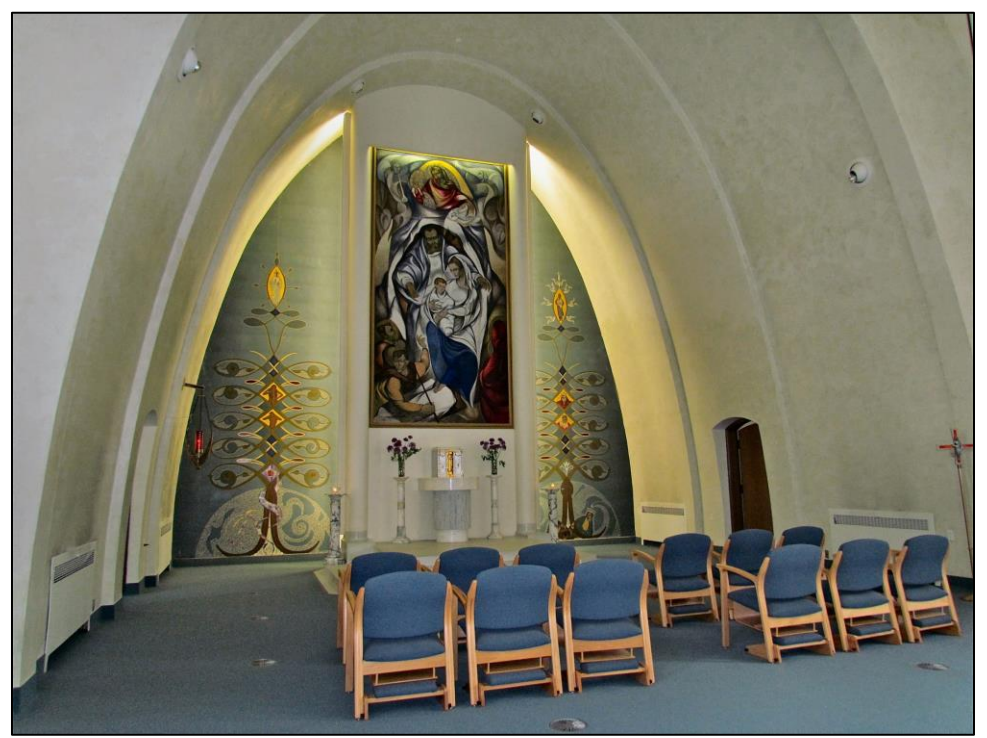
Head South down Hwy #6 toward Hamilton
