

Lord, hear the prayers of your people as we seek to serve. Grant our needs according to your will. We ask this in Jesus' name.




Altar Antependium

The antependium is predominantly gold and red, the school's colours. The red flames symbolize pain which is quelled by the hands of the nurse which on earth become the healing hands of God. They offer water, solace and love.


