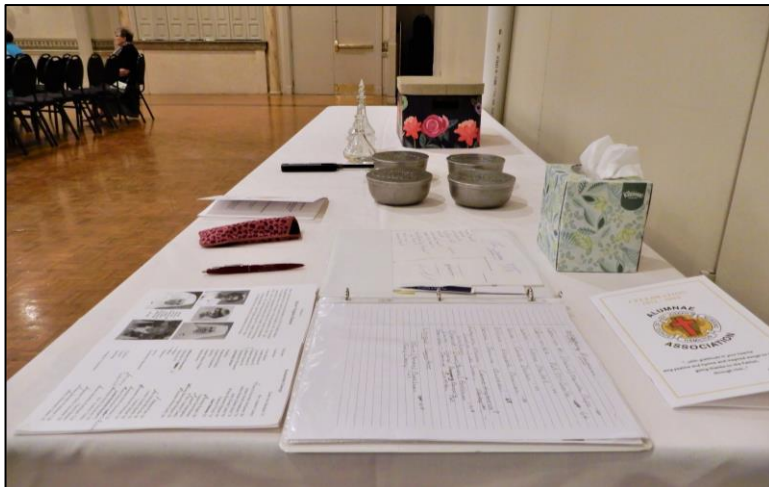


## Altar Antependium
