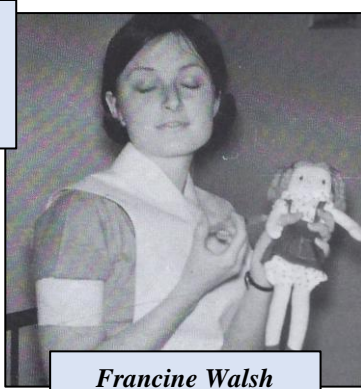
**The class of 1968 arrived August 31, 1965**

A skit of true to life room-mate relationships was portrayed and remembered as well as Isolation Technique.

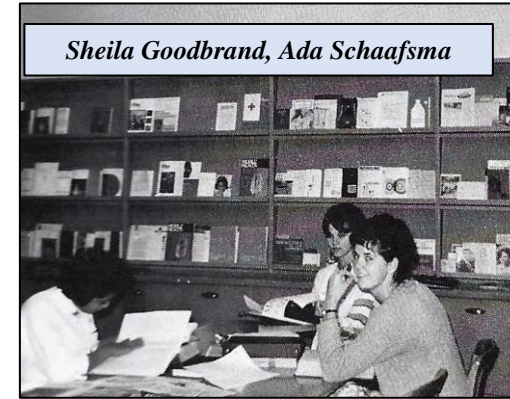
The party ended with the class songs of '66 and '67 and hearty cheers for the class of '68 with hopes for three good years.

## *Valedictory Address*

This is our Day: These are the thoughts of the graduates ... memories related to events of the past 3 years ... anxious thoughts reaching out to the future ... warm feelings experiencing pride in ourselves today.

The expectations of a nurse are very high. Many demands are made on the nurse's understanding, patience, and humility. Qualities such as loyalty, trust, honour, friendliness, obedience, usefulness, thrift, and courtesy must become ours, -- what a goal we set for ourselves as we become identified as nurses. To the patient a nurse offers a gift not of what one has, but of what one is. The privileges such as we enjoy, entail responsibilities. And indeed, if these could be enlarged upon it would be impossible to encapsulate them all for you, in such a short address.

Nursing is a challenge, one that comes from within. To be able from one's own self to draw a parallel for the treatment of others, and to feel with and for them has in nursing been termed empathy. This is the profession we chose to enter --- and for reasons so different that I am certain no two persons of the 113 graduating today are exactly identical. We had set a goal for ourselves to become registered nurses.

Let us consider for a minute what is entailed in achieving this goal. And I could ask: How do I approach my daily assignment? Am I afraid of the responsibility that is mine? Do I meet the demands that come my way with a confident, easy mind, because of my knowledge and skills. Do I greet the daily challenges with assurance or do I pause to view them fearfully? Did you know that: "You can do as much as you think you can, but you'll never accomplish more; if you're afraid of yourself, young adults, there's little for you in store. For failure comes from the inside first, it's there if we only knew it and you can win, though you face the worst, if you feel that your going to do it. Be the best of whatever you are."

Sometimes wonder what the most important aspect of nursing is to different people. Does nursing evoke the same response from each of its practitioners? It could be asked -- does team nursing represent the same ideal and function to all the participating members? Does a lecture from a doctor tend to leave us unquestioning? The time has come for us to honestly ask, are we ready to face a profession of challenging situations with open knowledgeable minds, with confidence in our ability as individuals, as nurses? No two people are the same in their approach to a situation so let your individuality shine forth in the final analysis, my friends, you must be you and no one else.

You might ask me for a motto and I would quote Dr. Schweitzer who identified for us the motto "Service". He said, and I quote -- "Let the world accompany each of you throughout your life. Let it be before you as you seek your way and your duty in the world. May it be recalled to your minds if ever you are tempted to forget it or to set it aside. It will not always be a comfortable companion but it will always be a faithful one."

And it will be able to lead you to happiness, no matter what the experiences of your lives are. Never have this word on your lips, but keep it in your hearts. Any may it be a confidant that will teach you not only to do good but to do it simply and humbly."

In the past three years of living with others, sharing with others and learning from others, we have been most fortunate. Throughout our many and varied experiences, we have learned patience and tolerance towards other human beings-- our friends. A sincere friendliness is one quality we can bring to every human encounter.

"Responsibility" is another word with so very much meaning. Responsibility to ourselves, to our patients, to our profession, and of course to our Parents. It takes maturity and love to be true to God and yourself -- especially under the stress of illness, in atmosphere of death, life, hope and the inevitable.

We might say, that Metamorphosis has been occurring during the past 3 years. We have met and worked with a great many people and each has contributed to our growth in some special way and from each we have gained new insights.

An expression of thanks to those who have done so much for us, can perhaps best be illustrated by our desire to reach out and use our nursing skill to the best of our ability. To Sister Celestine and Sister Maris Stella we want to say much more. Perhaps only now, as we draw to the end of our student years do we fully realize and appreciate their guidance, understanding and indeed patience, with us. Perhaps only time and maturity will disclose to us the essence of the educational experience.

We want to sincerely thank you Mother and Dad, for your enthusiasm and interest in our work. Your responsibility has not been easy at times -- how fortunate we are to have had you behind us all the way. You know that our thanks to you is deeper than words may reveal.

We also wish to thank the Teaching Faculty for their continual efforts on our behalf. The Sisters of St. Joseph and the Medical and Nursing Staff. May we show our appreciation by living up to the standards set for us by so many dedicated persons within the health profession.

In our younger years we looked with awe and admiration at the nurse, seeing strength and courage, and an understanding compassion for the sick. Today, I think we might do well to return to this earlier concept of the nurse, and continue to model ourselves on the ideal which was then and still is ours to attain if we wish. Thank you.

Welcome Sisters, Special Guests and Members of the Alumnae.

I am honoured to speak to you today on behalf of the class of 1968. We are celebrating a milestone year! 50 years have passed by since our graduation from St Joseph's School of Nursing. I would like to thank the organizing committee for asking me to represent our class. I also want to thank the committee for their time, energy and dedication in planning this very special celebration.

In the past few months, I have had the opportunity and the pleasure of speaking with many of my classmates. It is interesting, that although we haven't spoken in years, when we hear each others voice, it is like time has stood still. Such is the result of living together in close quarters, sharing everything – our stories, our laughter and tears – and often even our clothes! It is so true that the first one out is the best one dressed!

My mother-in-law used to say: "life is like a roll of toilet paper, the closer you get to the end, the faster it goes!" And here we are, 50 years later feeling like it was yesterday! I guess we are getting close to the end of our roll!

Reflecting back a half century is no easy task. I revisited my old yearbooks to refresh my aging memory. Margaretta Papp in her editor's message in our 1968 Vox Omnium quoted WB Yeats: "When you are old and grey, And full of sleep, Nodding by the fire, Take down this book And slowly read..." This is perfect advice for our 50th anniversary. So when you go home - take down your yearbooks and remember when...and make sure you have a box of Kleenex close by! In 1965, the year we entered nursing, St Joseph's Hospital marked its 75th year. Sister Mary Grace was the hospital administrator. She advised that electronics, automation, computerization and constant research were to be part of the new era of which we were to be the pioneers. Further, she said we would need faith, courage and knowledge to face these new challenges. As insightful and profound as these words were at the time – I am sure none of us had any idea of how technological change would impact our chosen profession.

As graduates of 1968, we were the pioneers of a new era. The torch was passed! At our graduation, we accepted the challenge and the responsibility, as registered nurses, to meet the demands of advanced technology and constant change. What we were experiencing in 1968 was just the tip of the iceberg – we had no idea of how rapid advancement in science and technology, and dramatic social and cultural change would affect our careers! It was an exciting time to be on the edge of an explosion!

Many of the grads of '68 continued their education obtaining university diplomas and degrees. Some took advanced courses in hospital administration, teaching, industrial nursing and public health. Others specialized in computer science, dialysis, labour and delivery and emergency room nursing. Among our graduates are entrepreneurs, teachers, nursing administrators and managers, nurse anesthetologist and a director with the Ontario Occupational Health Nurses Association. Not bad! I think Sister Mary Grace would be proud!

I am so grateful and appreciative to have had the opportunity to become a registered nurse and to have graduated with the class of 1968. We owe a great debt to all of our instructors and administrators at St. Joseph's. We especially want to thank Sister Joan O'Sullivan and Sister Ann Marshall, who taught us and nurtured us through our training years. To our Alma Mater.
