In Search For Status

Service Still Greatest Power

Competition for the services of nurses has never been so keen, graduates of St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing were told yesterday.

Pressures within the profession and attractive offers to train in other occupations lure many potential nurses away from nursing, Dr. Lawrence E. Lynch said.

THE HEAD of the department of philosophy, St. Michael's College, University of Toronto, was speaking to 107 graduates, their relatives and friends, at the school's 51st graduation exercises held at Punbome Hall.

Medicare and other health projects are all competing for recruits.

"And they are all going to pose their individual threats to your profession," he reminded graduates.

He cited statistics which show that 10 per cent of females holding their junior matriculation in Ontario enrolled in nursing programs in 1961. But by 1961 their numbers were reduced to about 10 per cent.



Receiving the guests will be Sister Celestine, director of nursing, and Mrs. Maurice Hastings, alumnae president.







Six Nations women honoured for their work

Two Six Nations women have been honoured for lifetime dedication to their passion in health and education.

Ruby Jacobs, the former health director of Six Nations, got a 2013 Indspire Award last month for her impact on the reserve's health-care system.

Arlene Berry, Six Nations first immersion school teacher in the Cayuga language, got a special educator award last weekend from Gov. Gen. David Johnston.

For Jacobs, the award – formerly known as an Aboriginal Achievement Award – caps a long career in nursing, health-care and community change.

"I was very honoured to accept it on behalf of my community and all the folks I worked with," said Jacobs.

When Jacobs joined the administration team at Six Nations after years of teaching nursing at Mohawk College, the health-care area comprised a handful of workers.

"That was in 1982. Our community is quite large and we didn't have proper services. By 2007 when I retired, we had developed 21 programs and some of them had programs within the programs," she said.

"We had an ambulance program, a birthing centre, home and community care."

With a community needs study that prioritized what the community wanted, Jacobs got to work; she researched the needs and necessary funding, made presentations to the local council, provincial government and federal government and got input into what kind of culturally appropriate programs people wanted.

"For instance, we asked the community what the birthing experience should be at
