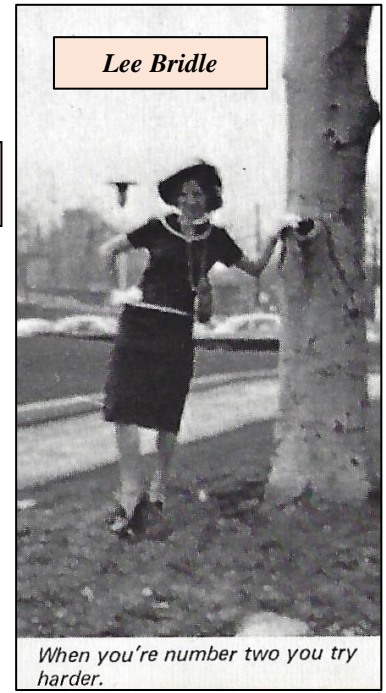

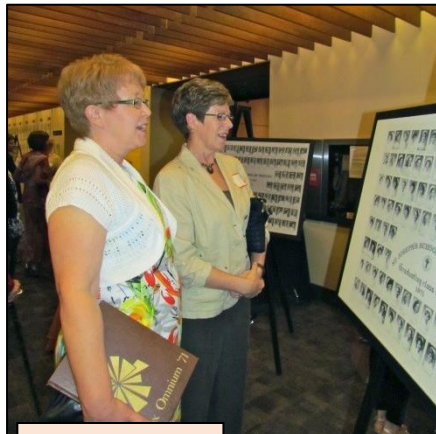

THE HIDDEN FAULT

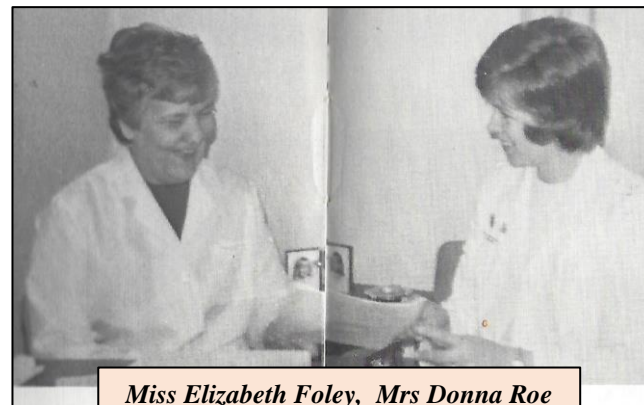

Nursing book features new learning method

"It's not a new book, but it's the first book," says Betty McInnis, an author of a new book on nursing education. 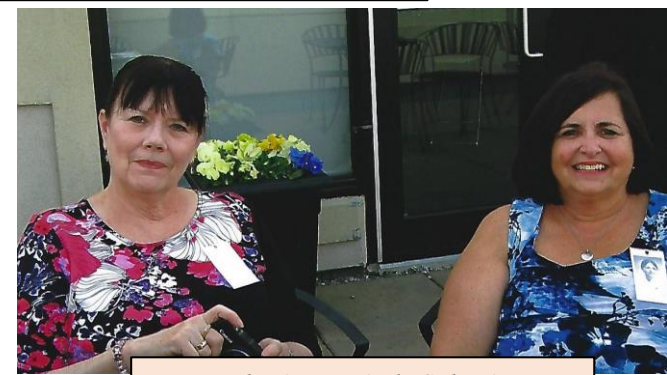

A new self-directed two year program began at St Joseph School of Nursing. Students were given modules with objectives requiring knowledge, comprehension and application of information. They identified what they needed to learn in biology, nursing and clinical nursing. They were evaluated by pre-and post-tests based on these objectives. The pass was 100% demonstrated in discussion with their nursing teacher as well as written exams.

To facilitate self-directed learning Betty McInnes developed many slide-tape programs and videotapes on anatomy and physiology and nursing skills to facilitate independent learning. As well, she wrote two books "Medical Asepsis" and "The Vital Signs" which students used as independent resources to learn the theory and skill of handwashing, isolation techniques and each of the vital signs.

The changing face of nursing

MEMORIES FLOWED like sweet wine yesterday as 800 graduates of St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing got together to celebrate the hospital's centennial and the 75th anniversary of the first graduating class.

May Mitchell Lewis, 77, and her daughter Francis Lewis Palmer, 39, are graduates of the school and both love nursing.

But while they share the love, their recollections of their profession are quite different.

Two years after her graduation in 1937, Mrs. Lewis found herself in the middle of the Second World War after volunteering to join the Canadian Army Medical Corps. After three years in England she was transferred to North Africa, where she and 80 other nurses set up a 1,200-bed tent hospital, in temperatures nearing 43C (110F), for Canadian casualties from the Allied invasion of Sicily.

"We were involved in general nursing care, looking after injuries from the war zone, malaria, small pox and various other diseases they would pick up. We had 12,000 to 15,000 patients at a time," she said.

All was not sickness and pain however. She met her future husband, Arthur Lewis, a Canadian soldier

Mrs. Palmer, who graduated in 1971, sees nursing today as very different from that of her mother's day. She said nurses have far more in-depth knowledge now.

"They are being relied on more by the doctors, other than the basic 'clean-up work' that my mom was involved in. A great deal of time spent by my mom was bed sitting, giving patients backrubs morning and night."

And the pay is much better.

Mrs. Lewis was paid \$5 for an eight-hour day when she started, while her daughter now makes \$15 an hour.

St. Joseph's School of Nursing graduated 3,000 nurses during its history until 1974, when it was integrated into Mohawk College School of Nursing.

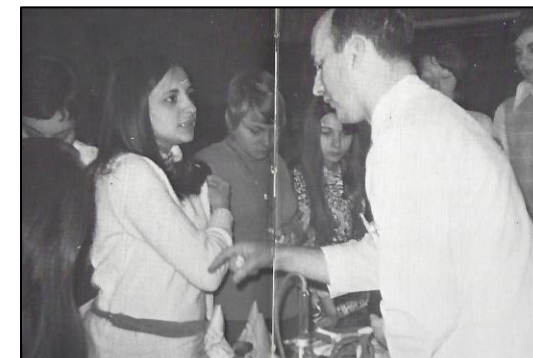

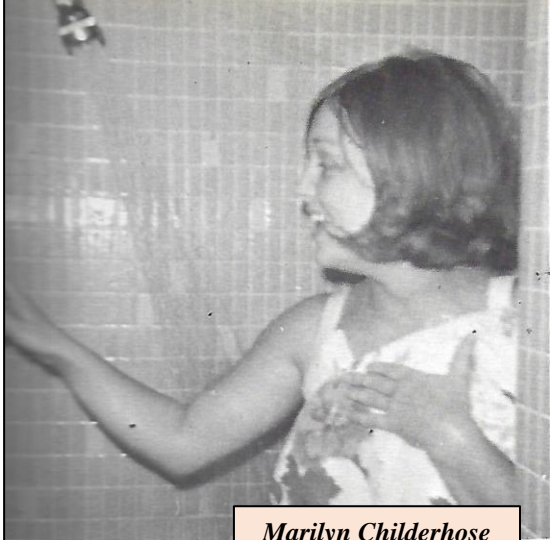

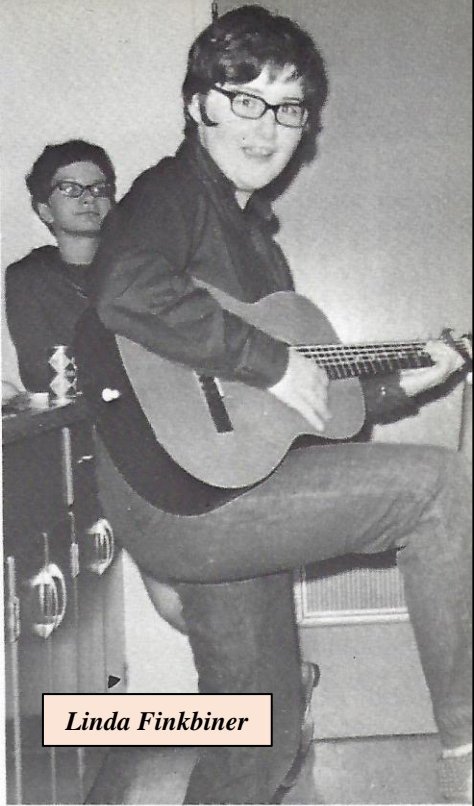
Flowers of hope

St Joseph School of Nursing will have 2 graduations in 1971.

Students who entered the school in September of 1968 will graduate in the Two – Plus – One program completing their year after graduation.

Sister Maris Stella, Director of St Joseph School of Nursing received word from the Ontario Hospital Services Commission and the College of Nurses in the fall of 1970, that the present Two – Plus – One program will be phased out following the 1971 spring graduations.

Students who entered St Joseph's School of Nursing in September 1968 completed the Two-Plus-One Program. Following the notice from the Ontario Hospital Services Commission & the College of Nurses the class became known as the Class of 1971 A.

They lived in Undermount for the 1st year & then in Fontbonne for their 2nd year. They provided their own housing for the 3rd year.

Their 3rd year was an internship year. When they left for the summer of 1970, they submitted applications to the hospital. These applications were for 6 months in a specialty area & 6 months in a general surgical or medical rotation. They were paid as hospital employees for approximately \$300 a month

*They wrote their Registration exams in May 1971
They graduated as Registered Nurses, June 11, 1971 at Mohawk College.
They began their careers as Registered Nurses.*

Students who entered St Joseph's School of Nursing in September 1969 had entered the Two-Plus-One Program Following the notice from the Ontario Hospital Services commission & the College of Nurses the class became known as the Class of 1971B

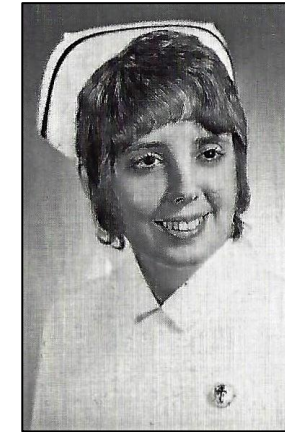
A small number of students lived in Undermount for the 1st year while the majority lived in Fontbonne. All the students lived in Fontbonne during their 2nd year.

St. Joseph's changes to two-year course

St. Joseph's School of Nursing is changing to a two-year nursing program.

Sister Maris Stella, director of the school, has received word from the Ontario Hospital Services Commission and the College of Nurses that the present Two-plus-One program will be phased out following the 1971 spring graduation.

Actually, the College of Nurses of Ontario, the approving body for schools of nursing, approved the two-year program for St. Joseph's in 1969. But the hospital had to await action by the OHSC.

In a two-year course, students graduate at the end of

two years of nursing education. In the Two-plus-One, they require the two years' nursing education plus one year of nursing internship or a service year in a hospital.

Phasing out the Two-plus-One program means that St. Joseph's School of Nursing will have two graduations in 1971. In the spring, students who entered the school in the fall of 1968 will graduate in the Two-plus-One course, completing their year after graduation.

In the fall of 1971, students who entered in September, 1969, will become the graduates of the school's first two-year course.

The two-year course is in effect at the Hamilton and District School of Nursing and Hamilton Civic Hospitals
