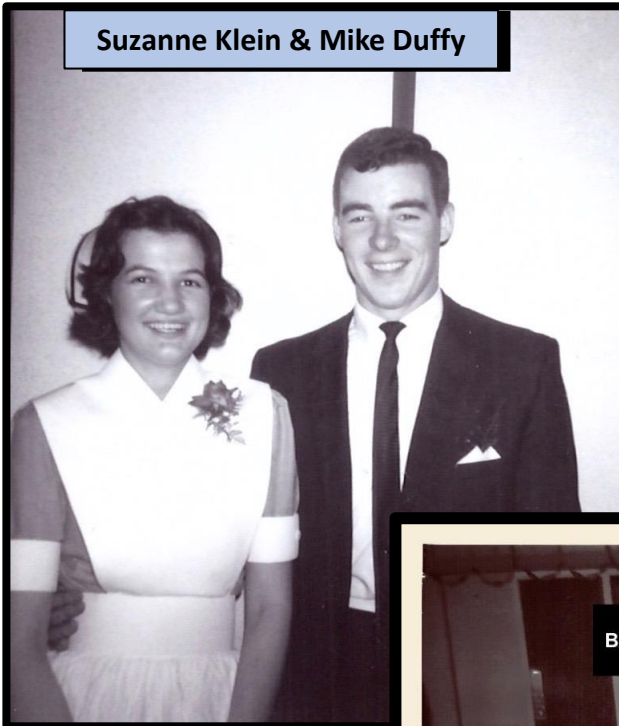

## Asks Graduating Class

### Consider City's Needs

The whole world awaits them, but the need is right here.

Ninety one nursing graduates from St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing, were asked yesterday to remain and work in Hamilton.

"WE NEED YOU desperately," Mr. E. L. Dubois, chairman of the hospital advisory board told the nurses at graduation ceremonies held in Fontbonne Hall. He reminded the graduates that they had received their training in Hamilton and hoped they would consider the need for nurses in the city.

He said St. Joseph's School of Nursing is the second largest in Ontario, yet out of more than 300 applicants received, only 126 girls could be accepted to begin training in the coming year.

"YOU NOW belong to a fine profession," he said. "Stand up to the high standards set for you."

Guest speaker for the graduation was Magr. B. T. Kyle, of St. Michael's Cathedral in Toronto.

He told the group that the ceremonies were not just another graduation.

"It is an extraordinary affair of extreme importance," he said, "provided that the motive that has caused you to offer your services is charity

or true love for one's fellow man."

HE CAUTIONED the graduates that the love must be unselfish and self-sacrificing.

"But this love makes the difference between an ordinary nurse and an extraordinary nurse."

He recalled the story of the prodigal son and told the nurses that this is the kind of charity they will be called upon to exhibit.

"You must see in every patient a child of God," he said.

The Most Reverend J. F. Ryan, Roman Catholic Bishop of Hamilton, who presented diplomas to the graduates, also addressed the group.

"I am sure that the high principles and holy thoughts instilled into your souls will remain and be a great help to you in your careers," he said.

GIVING the valedictory address, Miss Diane Surette, of Brantford, said the pins and diplomas the graduates received will be constant reminders that they have been prepared to accept the responsibilities of life.

Dr. J. B. Oubaldston, chief of staff, at St. Joseph's Hospital was chairman for the exercises and Mayor Victor L. Ogey brought greetings on behalf of the city.

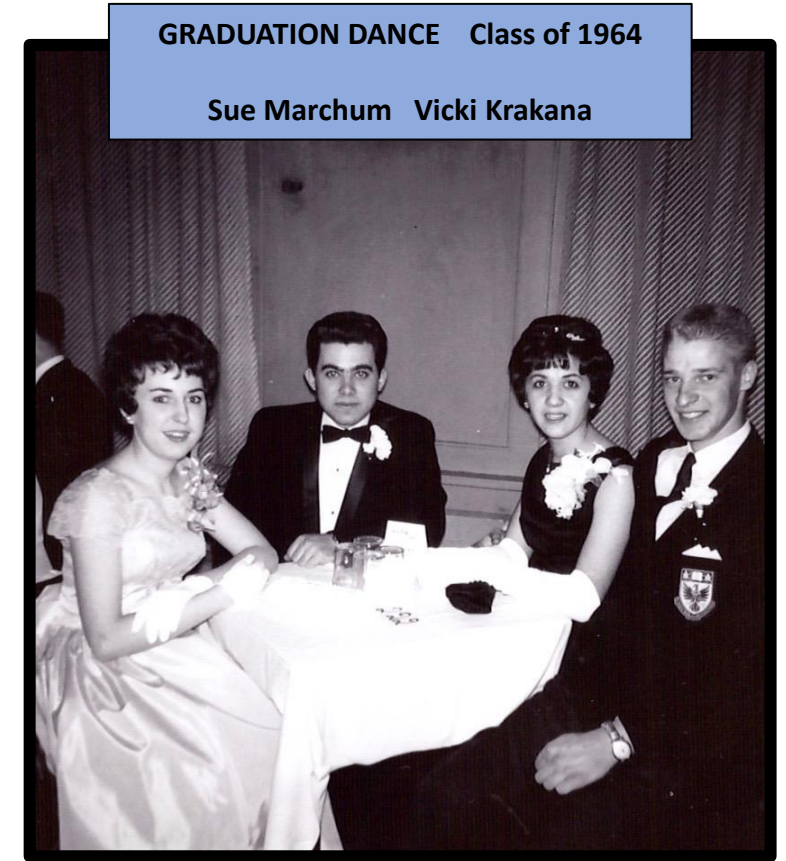

### *Sister Joan O'Sullivan and Marietta Pupo Honoured*

Two members of the St. Joseph's Hospital family are walking proud after being named Women of the Year by the Hamilton Status of Women Sub-Committee. In front of 900 people at the 14th Annual Awards at the Hamilton Convention Centre, Sister Joan O'Sullivan and Marietta Pupo, Reg.N., were honoured for their achievements.

Sister Joan, Assistant General Superior of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Hamilton, was named Woman of the Year in the Workplace category. Sr. Joan was presented with her award for her many accomplishments. Most notable is her ten-year term as Executive Director of St. Joseph's Hospital, her work in establishing the Good Shepherd Centre for Women and the Hamilton Women's Detox Centre, and her efforts in establishing the twinning of St. Joe's with the small Caribbean island of Dominica.

Named as Woman of the Year in Health, Sport and Fitness was Marietta Pupo. Honoured for her contributions to health care in the Hamilton community, specifically in the areas of maternity care, palliative care and her work with head and neck cancer patients, Marietta currently works as Clinical Nurse Specialist on 5 and 6 Surgery and effective at the end of April will be Clinical Nurse Specialist/Nursing Co-ordinator of the Palliative Care Consultation Team. A graduate of the St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing and a nurse at St. Joe's for more than 25 years, Marietta teaches at McMaster University. Something that speaks volumes about the kind of person Marietta Pupo has always been is the fact that she maintains strong links with many past and current patients.

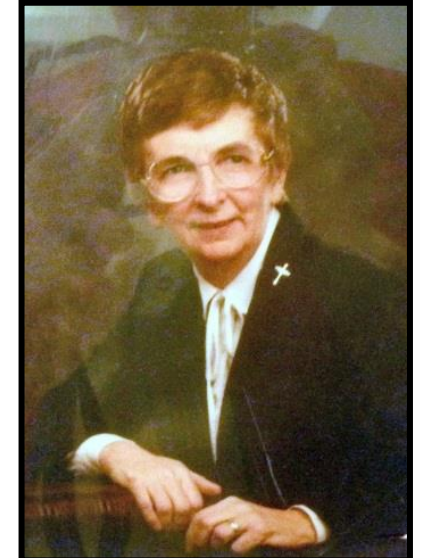
